Submitting Assignments:

All assignments will be submitted to my email address, not through Canvas. Also, make sure that the email address you are using for the course is the correct one that WVC has on file for you. If you are using a friend's ... your friend is going to be the one hearing from me, not necessarily you. So make sure you are using your own email address! Also, use your correct name as registered for the class. It is hard for me to figure out who you are if your name is different than on the roster. If there is a name change, please have your correct name on file with Admissions.
